PROFESSIONAL SUMMARY

Ms. Longacre currently serves as the Co-Owner of BEE Consulting, LLC working primarily in Business Development. Ms. Longacre also currently serves as the artist for Longacre Fine Art in Mukilteo where her paintings and sculptures have won national awards since her first exhibition in 2002. She was accepted by jury into the Oil Painters of America in 2004, and is represented in international collections. She taught Russian Impressionism in Mt. Vernon, Washington, contributed to Art for Health EAFA, and Art for the Arboretum Foundation, University of Washington.

Ms. Longacre also worked as a botanist for the UW CUH Herbarium in Seattle from 2009-2011 where she was a regular, independent volunteer and group member. She focused on specimen collection, identification, mounting, as well as historical specimen evaluation data entry and map development.





Ms. Longacre also spent many years as a Certified Emergency Nurse, RN for the state of Washington at several area hospitals. These include Everett General Hospital from 1986-1989 where she worked as a High Risk OB RN, Everett General Hospital where she worked as an Emergency Nurse, CEN, RN Level 2 Trauma from 1989-1999 and at Rural Metro in Edmonds where she worked as a Critical Care Ground & Air Transport, CEN, RN from 1998-2000.

Ms. Longacre's other positions include a Lead in the Plant Tissue Culture Research at the B&B Laboratories in Mt. Vernon from 1983-1984 and Manager at the WSU Plant Tissue Culture Lab, Research Unit in Mt. Vernon from 1980-1983. She also worked as a Park Ranger with the US National Park Service in Mount Rainier National Park from 1976-1979.
